

# Ace Your Interviews!

**Would You Hire You?** First impressions count - you've heard it said so many times. Making an excellent first impression is essential for a strong (and successful) interview. This includes your appearance, your timeliness, but most importantly, your interviewing skills! Interviewing well is a skill – and skills are developed and refined through practice. **Before heading into your next interview, spend 30 minutes using our newest technology: InterviewStream!** InterviewStream provides video interview technology so that you are able to practice for any internship or job interview with the use of a computer and webcam. This tool provides feedback and tips of non-verbal behavior and communication missteps, plus it's very helpful for faculty/counselor assessment and advice.

## To get started:

- Go to <http://kutztown.interviewstream.com>
- Click Create Account, complete a short profile and choose your own username and password. Then Click Signup.
- Conduct a virtual interview! (you must have a pc with a webcam or contact the CDC to reserve a webcam)
  - Adjust the webcam on top and volume on the right side of the computer screen before beginning the interview.
  - The interviewer will ask you a question and you have no more than two minutes to respond. When finished with your response, click the mouse and it will stop recording.
  - "Review" to see your response. After each question, you can either "Retry", "Skip" or choose "OK" to move on.
  - When the interview is complete, you will receive an email with a link to view your responses. You can then email your interview to a professor, CDC staff member, friends, and family to review and give feedback.
  - Remember...you can retry answers or entire interviews...practice, practice, practice!

## Usage Policy:

The Kutztown University Career Development Center advises students to use this software as a tool for improving their interviewing skills. Please be aware you can share your interviews via email with multiple constituents such as faculty, career staff, employers, alumni, mentors, friends and family. However, if you decide to send your InterviewStream video to any of these constituents, you should be respectful of the commitments that faculty, employers and alumni manage. Be advised that email is not a secure medium and your messages could be forwarded.

InterviewStream videos should not be used as a substitute for face-to-face interviews or without appropriate feedback.
